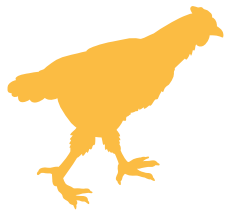
Greetings, I am a broiler and can reach an age of six months here. In conventional agriculture, we broilers are slaughtered after a lifespan of 40 days.

Servus, as an organic broiler chicken I can live in a stable with a maximum of 4,800 chickens.

There can be a maximum of 2 stalls in Bio-Austria farms - i.e. 9,600 chickens. In conventional agriculture there are no upper limits. In Austria, the farms keep chickens on average between 8.000 and 25.000 chickens, also large companies with up to 40,000 chickens are in Austria.
